Placing your memorial order...

Step 1: Choose the card format you prefer. ie., memorial card, bookmark, keepsake etc. and take note of the reference number.

Step 2: Choose the theme for your card, or supply your own background images.

Step 3: Choose the verses or prayers for your card from our wide selection on pages 32 - 35, or include your own at no extra charge.

Step 4: Complete the enclosed order form and enclose your photograph(s) of the deceased.

Photos: Please send us the best quality original photographs, not copies, or ink-jet printouts. Where necessary, indicate your loved one by marking an 'x' on the reverse of the photograph. All photographs will be reproduced from the original supplied and will be returned with your order.

Digital images must be large file size, high resolution (300dpi) uncropped and unedited. Please make sure it is the original and not a screen shot/grab of the photo. They can be emailed to: info@kpsmemorialcards.com

Proofs: A proof copy of each card will be emailed to you. Where an email address is not provided, a proof will be sent via post (postal proof is printed on 100gsm A4 Paper). It is very important that you read through all proofs and make sure that spelling, layout, design, images, prayers, dates, addresses and names are correct.

PLEASE ALLOW APPROX. 28 WORKING DAYS FOR DELIVERY FROM PLACEMENT OF ORDER.

Re-orders: It is always more economical to order extra cards at the time of the initial order, however we keep all orders on file for approximately 6 months, so if you need any more copies we can reprint them for you at the cost of standard cards.

Delivery

- When you place an order, we suggest you have it delivered to a work address rather than a home address, as our couriers only deliver between 9am and 5pm, and require a signature on receipt.
- Your order will be dispatched via the most suitable carrier, depending on size and weight.
- Unfortunately, we do not offer an Express Delivery option on European deliveries. Once your parcel has arrived in your country, it will be passed on to an internal postal service, according to standard delivery procedures.
- If you are not available when your parcel is delivered, the delivery driver will leave a calling card with instructions on how to pick it up.
- Delivery is included within Ireland, please contact a member of our customer service team for delivery outside of Ireland.

Simply email or enclose the picture of your loved one, together with verses taken from our range.

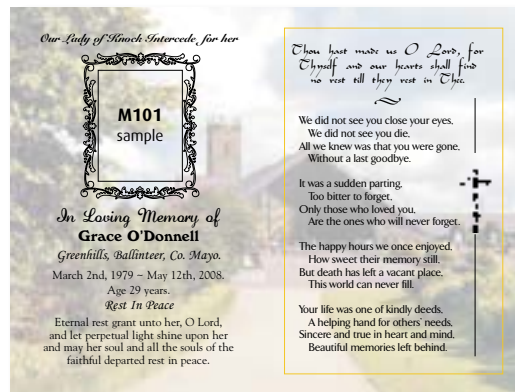
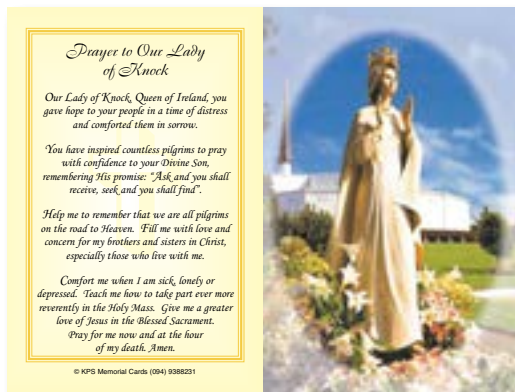
